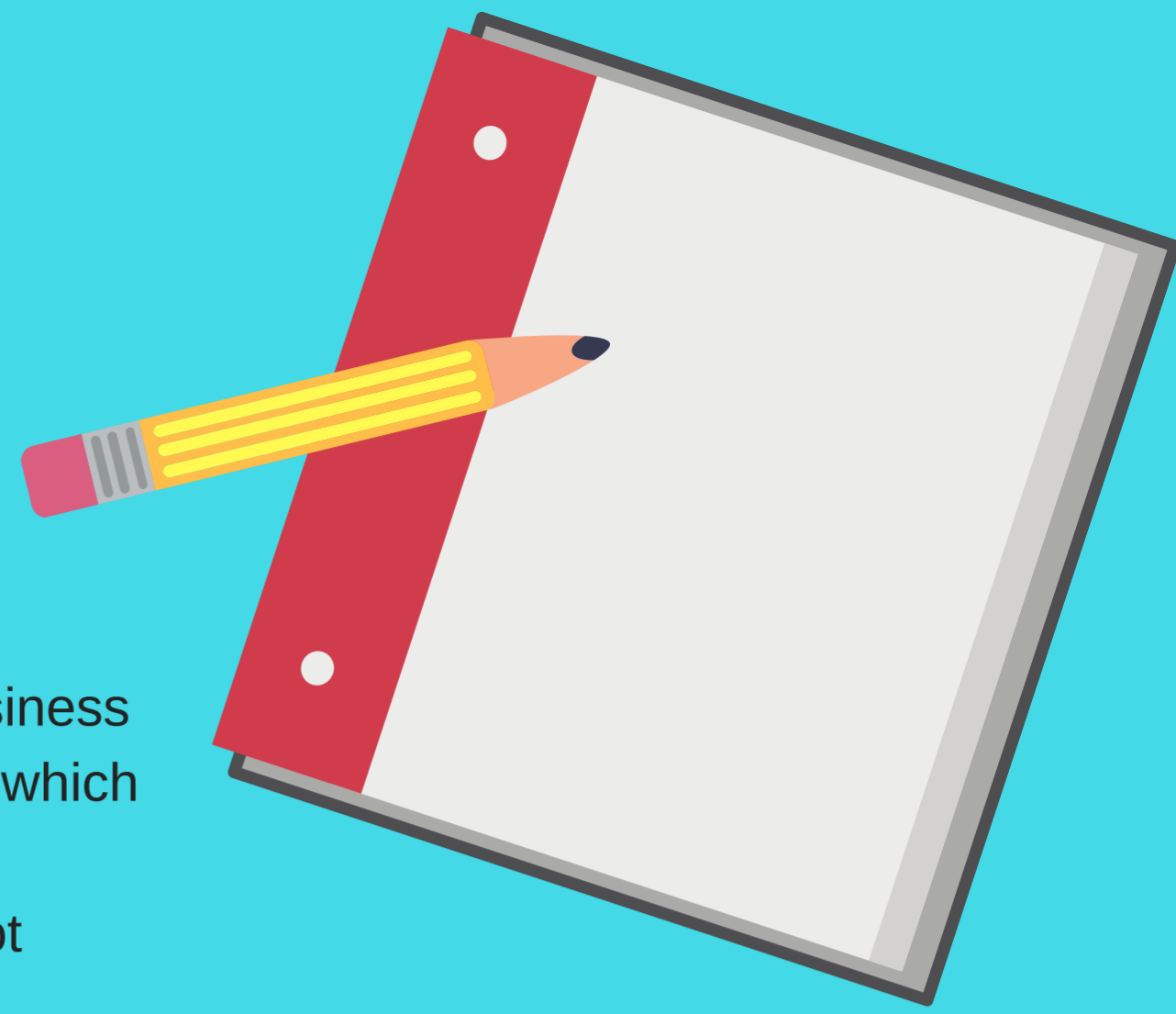
## MBA Research

## Innovation, Creativity and Entrepreneurship – Coming to you LIVE from Business Horizons!

Description: Engage with Iowa high school students participating in the weeklong Business Horizons program. In this unique 2-day PD, participants will see the impact on student learning of innovation, entrepreneurship and problem solving education. During Day 1, participants will shadow high school students engaging in the final day of Business Horizons – listen to pitches, watch infomercials, network with industry advisors, and promote their innovation at the end of event trade show. During Day 2, participants will build content knowledge in entrepreneurship, understand the connectivity between innovation, creativity and entrepreneurship, get introduced to the latest methodologies used to teach entrepreneurship including the Lean Startup Methodology (Business Model Canvas, Customer Discovery) and Design Thinking, develop a network with like-minded educators, AND leave with hands on resources ready for immediate use in the classroom. Participants will also learn about additional teacher professional development programs available, including BizInnovator ([www.bizinnovator.org](http://www.bizinnovator.org)) and STEM Innovator ([www.steminnovator.org](http://www.steminnovator.org)). Educators attending the two-day workshop will have the option to earn 1 University of Iowa graduate credit for \$75 – sign up for graduate credit will take place Day 1 of the workshop.
